Saturday, June 26 Park Seed Festival Of Flowers & Historic Abbeville

Time: 8 a.m. to 5p.m – 9 Hours

Lunch: on your own and not included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$25

Enjoy bus transportation to Greenwood, SC to visit the Park Seed Company where you will experience the annual South Carolina Festival of Flowers. After the cool hours of the morning are spent touring the beautiful flower gardens, the bus will travel to historic Abbeville. It is an easy walking on the streets of Abbeville where several options for lunch will be found. Abbeville features a famous Opera House, historic Belmont Inn and Trinity Episcopal Church. There will be a stop at Swartzen & Truberø Bakery for delicacy treats! Then return to Greenville along a beautiful mountain path.

Sunday, June 27 Breakfast, Beauty & Blessings

Time: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m – 4 Hours

Breakfast: Included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$22

Travel to Pickens County through the beautiful hills of South Carolina. Once in Pickens, you will enjoy a breakfast buffet at **Aunt Sue's**. After breakfast you will enjoy more mountain scenery featuring **Pumpkintown and Sassafras Mountain**, the highest point in South Carolina. Upon returning to Greenville the bus will take you to see the **Historic Downtown Churches** before returning to the Hyatt Regency Greenville to find your seat for the Opening Ceremonies at 1p.m.

Monday, June 27 Visit Columbia – A Capital Idea!

Time: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m – 8.5 Hours

Lunch: Included in the price of the tour.

Cost: \$25

Travel to South Carolina's historic capital. The tour group will begin in Columbia with a special tour of the **Governor's mansion**, and then move on to the **South Carolina State House**. There will be a picnic in a local park (rain plan is in place) where box lunches will be provided before the group. After lunch you will visit the **South Carolina State Museum** and other Columbia highlights as time permits before returning to the Hyatt Regency just in time to participate in your district caucus before South Carolina night at 6:30 p.m.

Tuesday, June 28 Visit Charlotte, NC – The Queen City (option 1)

Time: 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m – 8 Hours

Lunch: On Your Own

Cost: \$25

The bus will travel across the North Carolina border to beautiful Charlotte. The tour group will begin in Charlotte with a visit to the **Billy Graham Library, home place, and prayer garden**. After lunch on your own, the bus will allow attendees to either shop until you drop at the **Concord Mill Mall**, where the old textile mill has been converted into a fabulous mall, or for a mere \$17.95 attendees may opt to tour the premiere **NASCAR Hall of Fame**. The group will return to the Hyatt Regency in plenty of time to attend the Evening of Elegance at the annual Banquet & Ball at 7:00 p.m.

Tuesday, June 29 Greenville Museums, Industry & Cultural Extravaganza (option 2)

Time: 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. – 8 Hours

Lunch: On Your Own

Cost: \$25

The bus will travel across the city of Greenville and up the I-85 corridor to **the BMW Manufacturing Corporation complex** where you will be given a 90-minute tour. **You must wear completely enclosed, flat-heeled shoes (athletic or walking shoes), and you will be given a headset to wear before you enter the BMW tour.** The bus will stop for lunch on your own before a riding tour through the lovely **Furman University Campus**. Next stop will be the renowned art display at **Bob Jones University Museum and Gallery**, where 14th-19th century western culture arts are on exhibit. You will return to downtown Greenville for a walking tour of **Falls Park on the Reedy River**. You will drive past the baseball stadium and **Shoeless Joe Jackson** museum on the way to the **Up Country History Museum**. To say you've seen Greenville, SC and experienced the local flavor, this is a Must-Do tour!

Wednesday, June 30 The Discovery Tour

Time: 2:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. – 4.5 Hours

Lunch: On Your Own

Cost: \$20

Just because the conference has closed doesn't mean the cultural tours will not continue. Join this tour to visit the **Greenville Workforce Center** to *discover* the workforce system South Carolina style. The bus will travel through the countryside and *discover* where the textile industry once thrived. The next destination will be the campus of **Clemson University**. This campus will provide a true cultural discovery. You will marvel at the beauty

of the **Clemson Botanical Gardens** and the **Campus Creamery** where the group will have the option of an ice cream treat on your own. In this area there are numerous remnants of the former textile era of the Up Country, which is now known for other industries. Your cultural experience does not have to end here! You may reserve a dinner table and purchase theatre tickets for \$15 to see the feature at the **Café & Then Some**, where the bus will drop you for a lively evening. About 9:30 p.m. the walk back to the hotel is a safe block and a half. You may also opt to return to the Hyatt Regency Greenville to prepare for the next day!
